### Field Procedures

BGSC Home Games are played at community turf and grass fields. These facilities are open to the public.

We ask that our players, Coaches, Managers, parents and opposition adhere to the following at our home fields (Byrne Creek High School turf, Burnaby Central HS turf, Riverway Sports Complex and Burnaby Heights Park):

#### **Players:**

- Arrive at the field dressed ready to play (no change rooms but washrooms are open)
- Bring along a mask as it is recommended for everyone in the bench area to wear a mask.
- Bring own water bottle
- Sanitize their hands before entering the field and leaving

#### **Managers:**

- Visiting teams will be responsible for their own sanitization and masks
- Player benches and canopy tents will be permitted at our sites

#### **Parents:**

- Parents are always required to remain off the turf surface
- Parents are permitted use of the track for exercise only, no standing on track to view games
- Social distancing is always required, and masks are preferred
- If assisting with nets, please sanitize hands before and after and wear a mask

As our facilities are open to public use, teams are asked to maintain social distancing from all other groups and teams when entering and exiting the field and the facility. The optimal pathway to do so may vary depending on the other activities taking place on site.
