Burnaby Girls Soccer Club Remembrance Day Tournament Rules & Guidelines 2022

There are 2 separate competitions your team is entered in:

- 1) 6 or 7 a-side games (U8-U13 play 7 aside, 6 plus a goalie & U14-U18 6 aside, 5 plus goalie)
- 2) Penalty Shot Shoot-Out

Winning teams will be named in each separate competition.

Each team plays their game followed by the Penalty Shoot Out competition. After your game proceed immediately to your Shoot Out location (SO #1-#4) in the end zones of Field #1 and the Mini field (SO #5).

Rules for 6 aside and 7 aside Games

- Home team (listed first) supplies the game ball.
- 2 x 13 min halves, switch ends at half time, no stoppages.
- No offsides
- Substitute on the fly.
- A ball going over the end line by the defending team is an indirect kick from the point of leaving (no corner kicks). If inside the 6-yard box then it is to take place from the corner of the end line and the 6-yard box.
- No throw-ins. Ball over sideline is a kick-in.
- After a goal the ball is brought to centre and play begins immediately.
- In the event of a colour conflict the Home team (team listed first) will wear pinnies.
- All Referee decisions are final.
- Scores only need to be reported for teams playing in groups consisting entirely of teams U13 and older.

The groups which require score reporting are:

- Group F
- Group G
- Group H
- Scores are to be reported **within 30 min of game end**.
- The **winning team** (or the **home team** in the event of a **tie**) will text the score to the scorekeeping desk at **604-220-5812**.
 - Please include the following information with your text:
 - Group Name (ie. *Group F*)
 - Team Name registered with (ie. *Titans*)
 - Home Team Score
 - Away Team Score

- Alternatively, you can walk into tournament headquarters and report the score directly to the scorekeeping desk.
- Failure to report a score by texting, or reporting directly to tournament headquarters, will result in a forfeit of the points (in the case of a win) and a 1-0 win to the visiting team in the event of a tie.

Final Game Standings – **Standings only kept in U13+ divisions, no winners for the six or seven a side competition named in U8 through U12.**

3 pts for a WIN, one point for a tie.

- Ties will be broken by the following rules in order:
 - 1) Head to head results
 - 2) Lowest goals against
 - 3) Goal Differential (Total goals for minus Total goals against)
 - 4) Coin Toss

Penalty Shoot-Out Competition

- The shootout is a penalty shot competition.
- All players from each team shoot once. If one team has more players, then the team with fewer players WHO HAVEN'T SCORED YET shoot twice to create equal attempts for both teams.
- Play starts with the whistle from a designated spot.
- Scoring attempt ends with a save or ball striking post and staying out.
- The team with the most goals gets 3 points, the other team 0.
- In the event of a tie – sudden death occurs with one shooter from each team. The shooters selected must not have scored already.
- The team with most overall points in group wins.
- In the event of a tie in points the following rules apply:
 - 1) Head to head winner
 - 2) Total goals in all shoot outs
 - 3) Coin toss

Only Players, Coaches and Managers are permitted in fenced in areas of the fields.

Water bottles with water only are permitted in the fenced in areas of the fields.
No food allowed in that area.

This is a fun tournament!!! Please help us keep it that way and stay within these rules and guidelines.

BOTH Competitions are considered to be in the SPIRIT OF FAIR PLAY.

Any abuse of tournament referees, officials or volunteers will not be tolerated.
